TABLE TOPS

Clean our standard tabletops frequently to keep grime from settling in. A buildup of grime on these surfaces can cause stains or scratches.

Casala table top products are exclusively manufactured with E1-grade wood and MDF that meets European quality standards. In addition, all of our wood is PEFC and FCS certified. Casala table tops are manufactured with Döllken Fusion edges, which results in perfect, rock-solid and adhesive-free connections. In addition, Casala offers the possibility to supply the table tops in a variety of wood veneers.

Our standard table tops are finished with a type of laminate, a synthetic material that can be manufactured to look like natural stone or wood. The surface of our table tops are water resistant and will last a long time if cared for properly.

Cleaning Method

1. Wipe dust and crumbs off the tabletop using a soft cloth. When these are removed, shake out the cloth and dampen it with water.
2. Sprinkle baking soda on the damp cloth. Rub this very gently over any stained or heavily soiled areas of the tabletop. There is no need to rinse it off yet. Abrasives aren't generally recommended for laminate surfaces--however, you can use dampened baking soda, which is mildly abrasive, to remove stains.
3. Wet a soft sponge under warm, run-

ning water. Wring it out and apply a teaspoon of liquid dish detergent to the sponge, or directly onto the tabletop.

4. Scrub the tabletop one section at a time. In between sections, rinse out the sponge and add a drop of dish detergent to it if the sponge becomes very soiled.
5. Rinse off the table with a clean sponge or towel soaked in clean water. Rinse well to avoid hazy residue or a tacky feeling from the detergent.
6. Dry the tabletop immediately with clean towels. Buffing it dry with towels prevents streaks and spots from water.

Tips & Warnings

If your sponge holds onto dirt and grit even after rinsing, get a new sponge to finish cleaning the tabletop. Rubbing laminate with dirty, gritty sponges will scratch them. Never scour our tabletops with scouring pads or scouring cleaners.

PLASTICS

Our furniture is manufactured from high quality materials. These are carefully selected in collaboration with specialists to ensure the outstanding quality of our furniture.

Cleaning Method

1. Clean the plastic by washing with plenty of water and mild soap.
2. Use a clean, soft, grit-free cloth, sponge, or bare hands.
3. Do not use gasoline, alcohol, benzene, acetone, carbon tetrachloride,

fire extinguisher or de-icing fluids, lacquer thinners, or window cleaning sprays because they will soften the plastic and cause crazing.

Be careful

Plastics should not be rubbed with

a dry cloth as this is likely to cause scratches, and also build up an electrostatic charge which attracts dust particles to the surface.



WOOD

Avoid extremes of humidity and temperature, which accelerate cracking of the finish.

Casala products are treated with water-based lacquers and staining agents. As such our products are less harmful to people and to the environment. All wood components can be finished with a fire resistant lacquer on request, bringing the product in line with international fire safety standards.

Cleaning Method

1. Vacuum or dust with a soft cloth. Occasionally use a cloth just barely dampened with solvent-based cleaning wax to wipe the surface to pick up more dust, and immediately wipe with a dry cloth or soft paper towel.
2. Do not use spray waxes and polishes on surfaces as they will leave a higher gloss and some silicone which may make future refinishing more difficult.
3. If waxing of the wooden finish is desired, use a wax or polish to give the desired amount of gloss.
4. For stubborn soil, wipe with a cloth wrung out of mild detergent and water solution; wipe with damp cloth; dry with dry cloth.



FABRICS

Our recommended cleaning solution for most stains consists of 0.5 ounce of antibacterial dishwashing liquid to 22.5 ounces of water.

Cleaning Method

1. Remove any residual soil by lightly brushing or scraping the stain. Attempt to remove stain by sponging with water.
2. If further cleaning is needed, apply light mist of our recommended cleaning solution using a spray bottle.
3. Work the solution into the stain by lightly scrubbing the area with a sponge or very soft bristle brush.
4. Remove cleaning solution with a wet-vac if possible, but at the very least blot with a clean soft towel or sponge to remove the stain and excess cleaning solution. Repeat steps 2-4 until stain is removed.
5. Rinse the affected area thoroughly with clean water applied with a spray bottle. Extract the remaining moisture using a wet-vac, sponge, or towel. Repeat rinsing method if needed to thoroughly remove cleaning solution from the fabric.



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
